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3-B PREA REPORT – December 27, 2018

3B Detention Center has participated two PREA audits. We passed both audits successfully and continue to work maintaining a safe environment for youth in our custody.

The PREA Standards contain 182 separate standards organized in over 40 sections. Each of the individual standards sometimes contains multiple requirements.

The 3-B Juvenile Detention Center fully supports the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 (PREA). For years the 3-B Detention Center has trained staff and residents on prohibited contact and inappropriate relationships to prevent the problem of sexual abuse within its walls.

The occurrence of sexual abuse at the 3-B Detention Center is very low, with no substantiated incidents within the facility in the last several years. However, we realize that we must keep up our efforts to combat this constantly. We will continue to have a strong zero-tolerance policy and environment with regard to all kinds of abuse. Results of investigations are used to determine if anything needs to be changed at the 3-B, including, but not limited to, policies, procedures, physical plant characteristics, staffing, shifts, personnel assignments, and supervision.

High levels of supervision, highly trained staff, and PREA education are the main tools used to prevent sexual abuse, physical abuse, bullying and other incidents in the center.

During the last year all 3-B Detention staff, volunteers, education staff, youth, and contractors have received PREA training.

I look forward to continuing to strengthening our partnerships with local agencies and the community by changing young people's lives.
